

Flower nests for boiled eggs

Collect from around your home

- Cardboard rolls of toilet or kitchen paper
- colourful scraps of cloth, old magazines or colourful adhesive film
- glue or double-sided tape
- Scissors

Step 1

Cut the side wall at the top of the cardboard roll 5 times with scissors. The cuts should be approx. 2.5cm deep. The distances between the individual cuts must be approximately the same size. With a toilet paper roll there are approx. 2.7cm between each cut.

Step 2

Cut a piece of fabric or paper, so that there is enough to go around the roll (7x15cm). Do not glue the top when the cuts have been made.

Step 3

Stick double-sided adhesive tape around the roll (or spread adhesive thinly). Attach the fabric all-round the outside of the roll.

Step 4

Now cut out 5 petals from the fabric. Fold the incised cardboard strips down a little outwards and glue one petal on each section. Allow the glue to dry before placing a boiled egg in the "nest" at the top of the roll.
